Aurora Park

What was once an underutilized site, Aurora Park represents more than a new green space. It is the result of a community-driven vision and an investment in the long-term health, safety and vibrancy of the neighbourhood.

The future park will include a small and large dog run area, open lawn space, accessible picnic seating, bicycle racks, shade trees and plantings, a playground, sloped play area, walking paths, a seating plaza and bench seating.

The playground will have inclusive play opportunities for a range of ages and abilities including: A swing set with a baby seat, varying sizes of slides, an inclusive net spinner, hill climbers, and natural play elements such as log steppers and boulder climbers.

Safety was a central consideration in the park's design. Features such as improved lighting, clear sightlines, an open layout and active gathering spaces support Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) principles and encourage regular community use.

Construction is expected to begin in spring 2027 .
